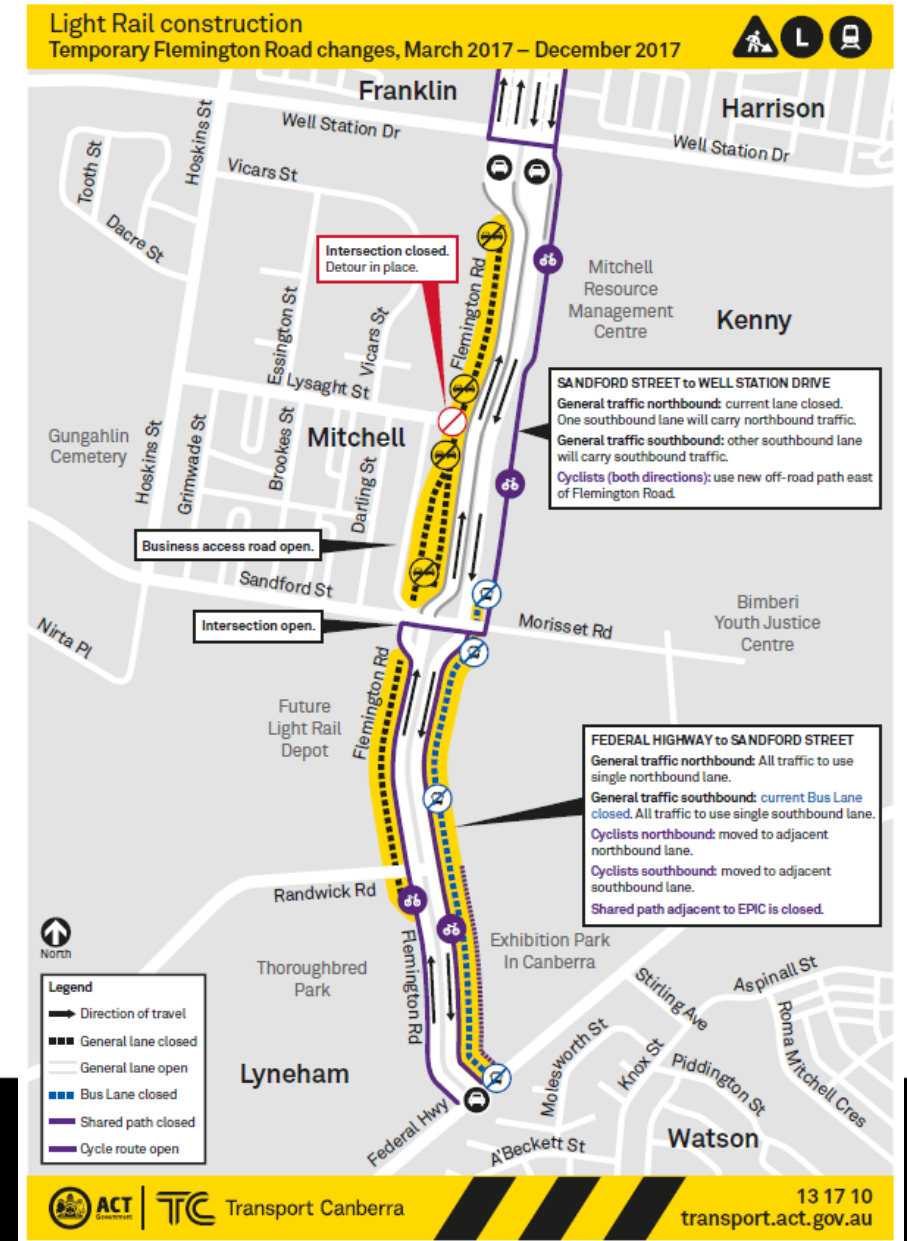

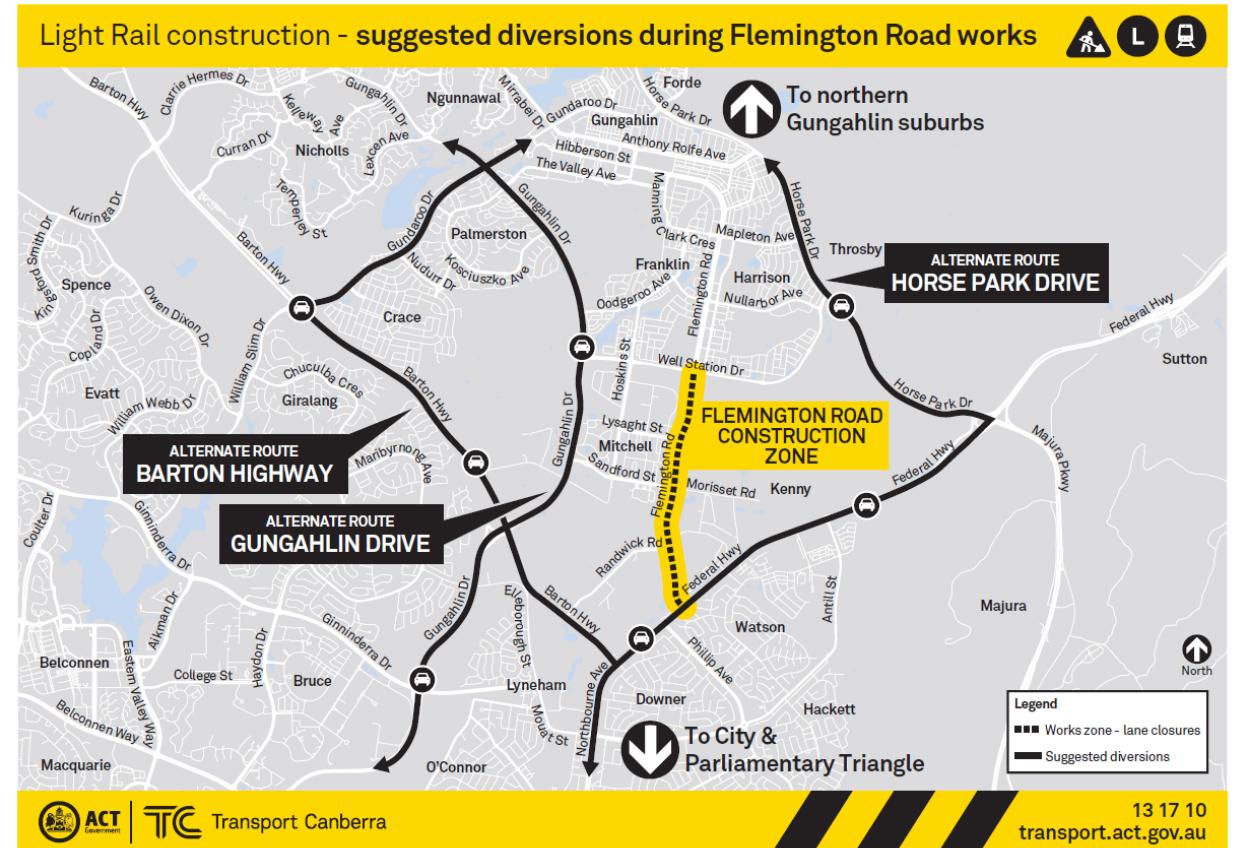
# Changes to Flemington Road

- Flemington Road will be reduced to a single lane of traffic for both northbound and southbound from Federal Highway to Well Station Drive.
- Access to the Lysaght Street Intersection will be closed.
- Sandford Street and Morisset Road intersection will remain open
- On road cycle lanes will be in place along Flemington Road between Federal Highway and Sandford St/ Morisset Road for each direction. Cyclists will then move over to the new off-road path east of Flemington Road for both directions.
- Access to businesses along the western side of Flemington Road will be maintained through the existing slip road.



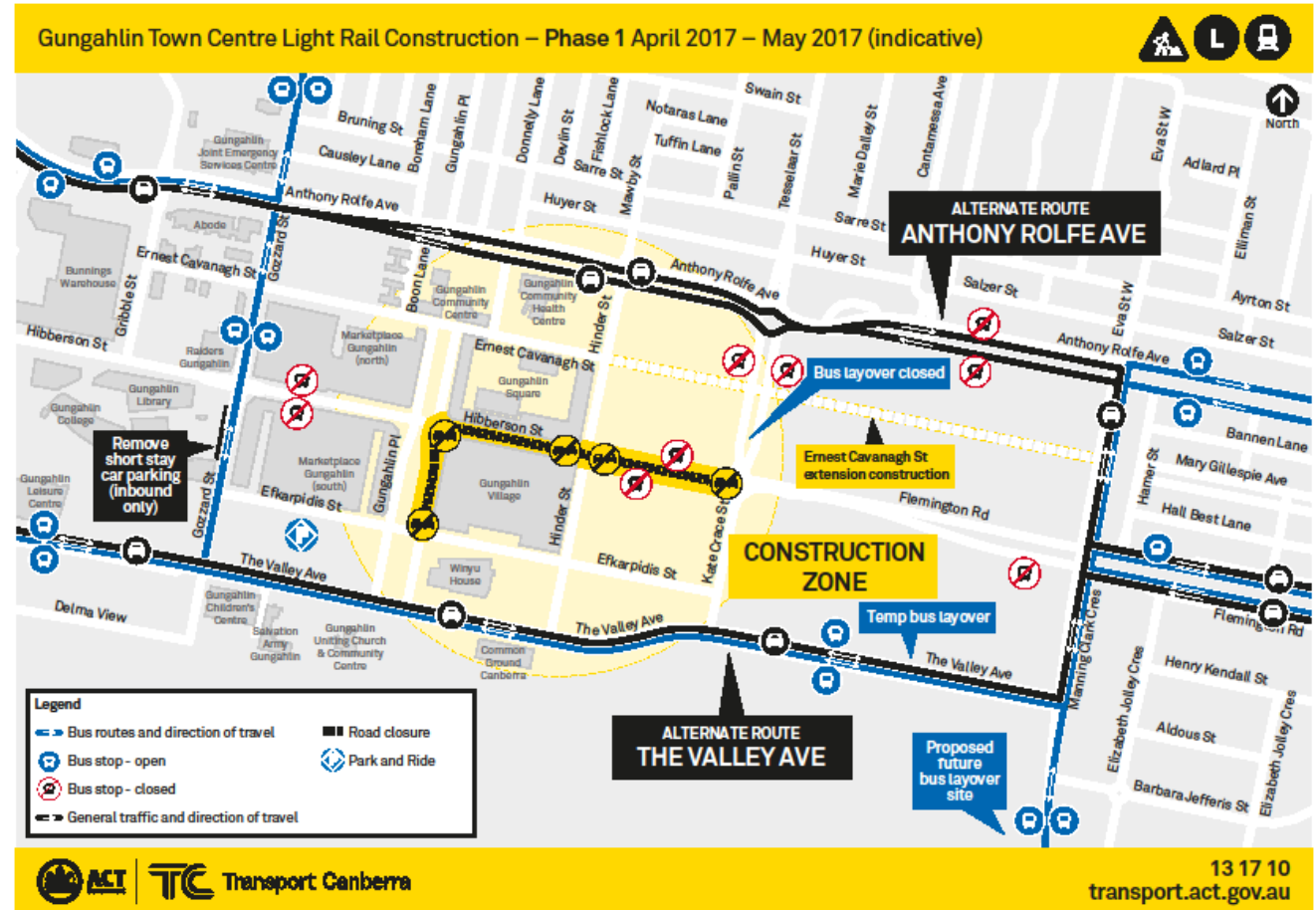
# Suggested diversions

- Flemington Road will remain open during this construction phase. It is expected that motorists will experience some additional delays along this route.



# Gungahlin changes, Phase 1

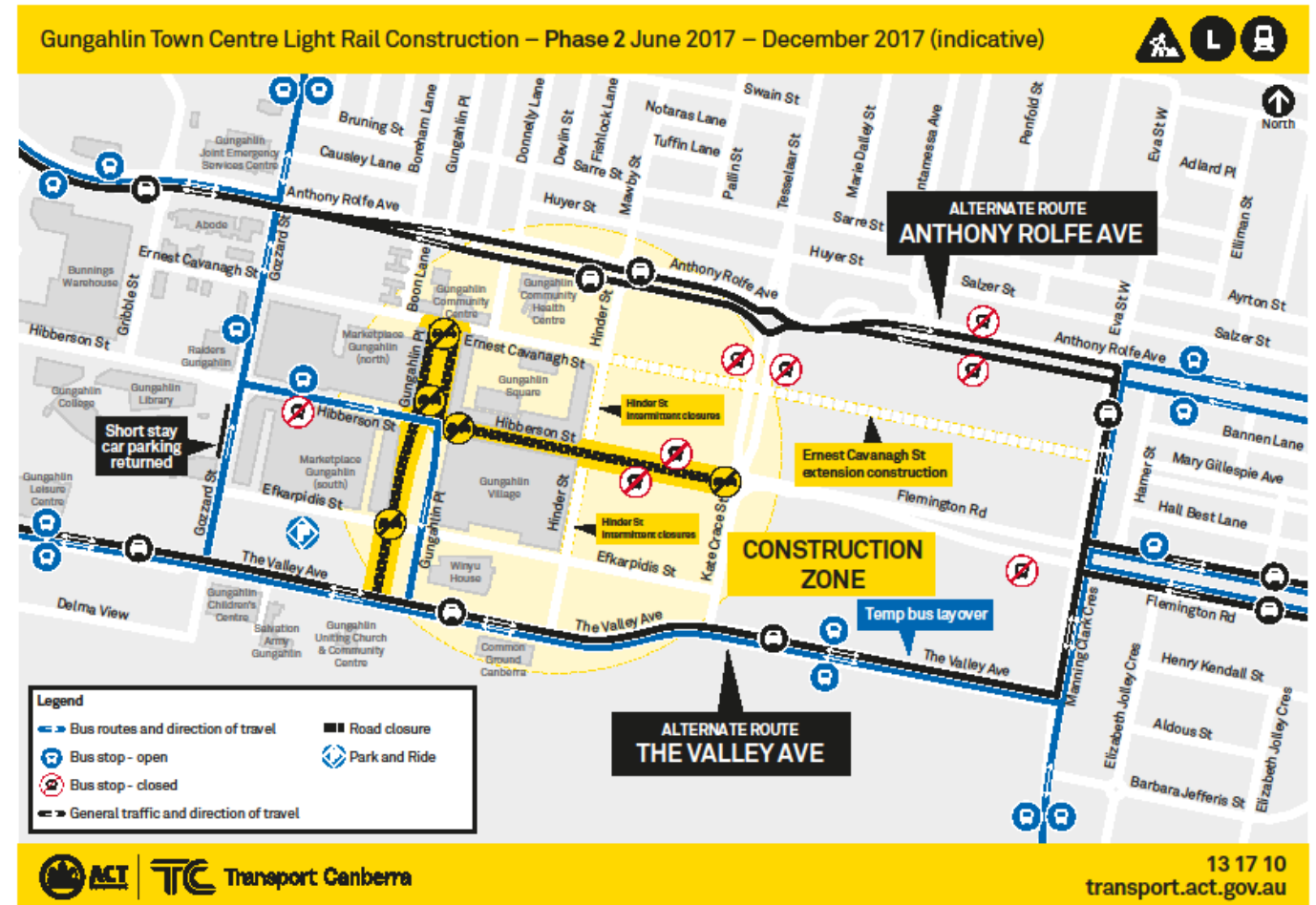
- Hibberson Street closed to vehicular access 10 April 2017
- Late March – Roads ACT to commence construction on Gungahlin Bus interchange in Gungahlin Place
- Southbound section of Gungahlin Place closed between Hibberson Street and Efkarpidis Street
- Phase 1 complete late May 2017.





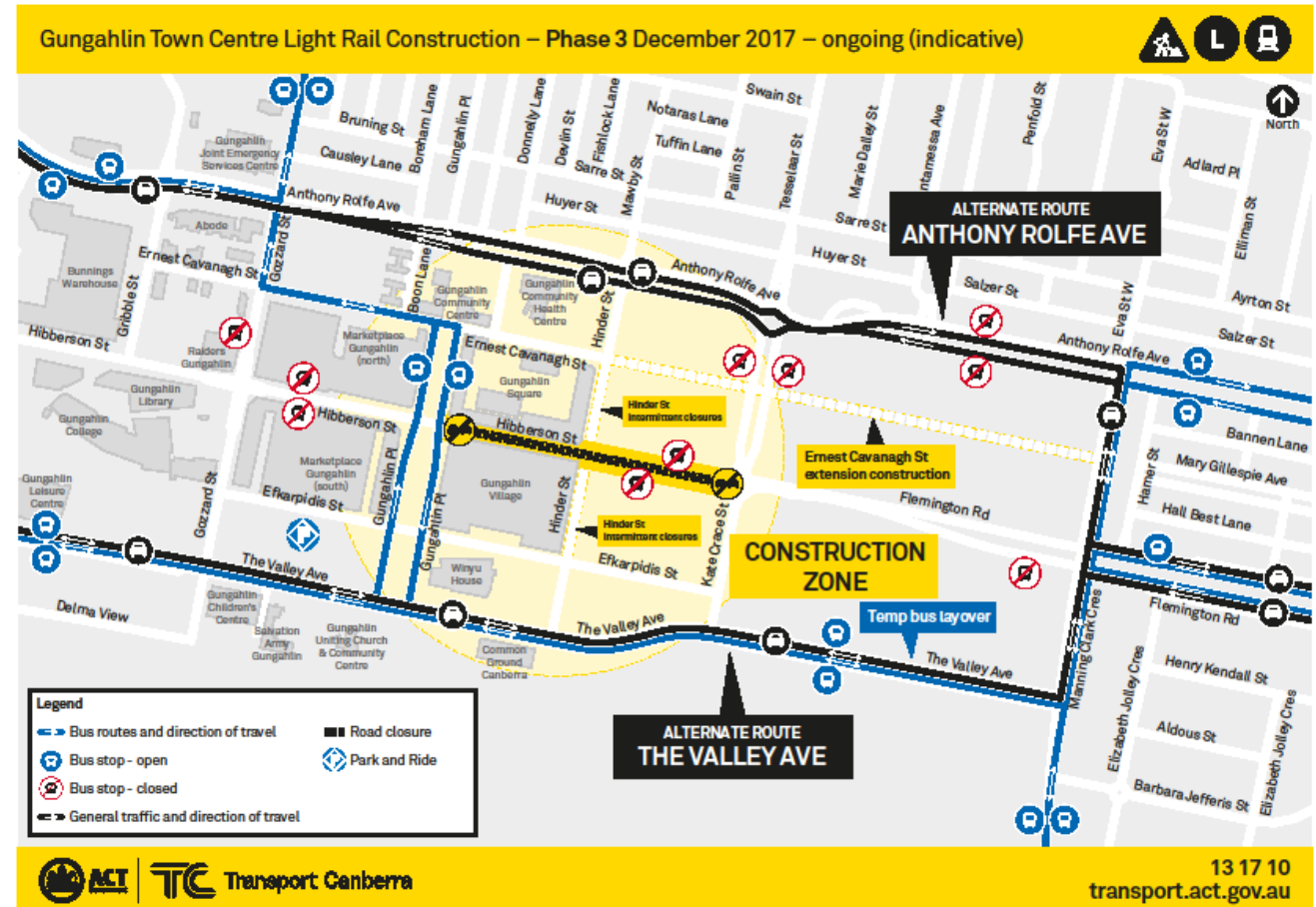
# Gungahlin changes, Phase 2

- Gungahlin Place closed both directions north of Hibberson and northbound lane closed between Hibberson and Efkarpidis Street
- Works planned for July to December 2017.



# Gungahlin changes, Phase 3

- Gungahlin Place opened for traffic and bus interchange finalised by December 2017.





# Gungahlin Town Centre Light Rail Construction – Phase 4 Light Rail services commence late 2018 (indicative)
